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IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS

Please read the following instructions carefully:

- 1. The complete Prospectus for the Counseling process is available on the College Website www.hpgdcshimla.org/, www.hpmds.smartpad.in/ and Directorate of Medical Education & Research, H.P. website www.hp.gov.in/hpdmer. Candidates may download the complete copy of the text of the prospectus and may read it carefully. Thereafter, apply online within the prescribed date with successful transaction of fee and obtain the print out of confirmation copy of ONLINE application form as per instructions mentioned in the prospectus. The print out of confirmation copy of online application form is required to be submitted along with requisite certificates/documents by the candidates in person on the day of reporting for admission in the concerned provisionally allocated college.
- 2. The provisional State merit list of qualified NEET-MDS -2021 who apply (online) to the H.P. State Centralized Counseling for taking admission in MDS course in Govt. and private un-aided Dental Colleges of the State for the academic session 2021-22 will only be drawn online and same will be verified by the Centralized /Common counselling Committee based on NEET-MDS-2021 result data received from Asstt. Director, DGSS, Govt. of India MoH&FW, New Delhi. The candidates who are not found to be qualified in NEET-MDS -2021, their application forms shall be rejected without any notice and names of such candidates will not figure in the merit list. The final H.P. state merit list of desirous applicants shall be displayed as per schedule in prospectus. The application fee shall not be refunded in any case. Hence, NEET-MDS-2021 non-qualified candidates needs not to apply for the H.P. State Centralized/Common Counseling.
- 3. Failure to complete any of the step for online registration for the Counselling or non-payment of the fee as per requirement of online process, final submission of online application will be considered incomplete and hence rejected. Mere deduction of fee does not mean that the online application form has been submitted successfully. In the event of failure of fee transfer to the specified account and non-generation of confirmation copy of the online application form, the Counselling committee shall, in no way be responsible.
- 4. Generation of confirmation copy confirms the correctness and final submission of application form. If confirmation copy has not been generated, this means that application has not been submitted successfully which will lead to rejection.
- 5. The desirous eligible candidates who qualify the NEET-MDS- 2021and meet other terms & conditions as laid down in the Prospectus clause-3 (A&B) are required to furnish result card mentioning obtained marks in NEET-MDS-2021 with the application form..

6. As per MDS Regulation (1st amendment), 2017 notified by Dental Council of India with prior approval of MOH&FW, Govt. of India. Eligibility criteria for applying for 50% State Quota and 50% Management Quota PG (MDS) Centralized/Common Counseling is as under: -

(i) General Category 50th percentile (ii) SC/ST/OBC 40th percentile (iii) Person with Disability 45th percentile

Provided further, that when the number of qualifying candidates in the respective categories on the basis of the above mentioned percentile are less than three times the numbers of vacancies, the cut-off percentile will be automatically lowered in such a manner that the number of eligible candidates shall be minimum three times of seats in each respective category.

- 7. The candidate(s) found ineligible at any stage shall have no claim for admission or continuation of PG degree (MDS) course even if he /she has qualified the NEET-MDS-2021.
- 8. All desirous eligible candidates, Direct and In-service, (M.O. Dental) who fulfill the prescribed eligibility criteria and other conditions of the Prospectus may apply through online mode only by using **online website www.hpmds.smartpad.in** for seeking admission to MDS courses in different Dental Colleges situated in the State of Himachal Pradesh in the different specialties.
- 9. In-service GDO (M.O. Dental) candidates are also required to apply through online mode for seeking admission to MDS courses along-with "Service-cum-No Objection Certificate" from the competent authority. Scanned copy of NOC is required to be uploaded in the mentioned website for registration for Counselling for PG (MDS) -2021 by the candidate, if same is not uploaded then he/she will not be given the due benefit of being In- Service candidate. However, his/her candidature and subsequent merit will be considered on the basis of actual marks obtained in NEET-MDS-2021. In case a GDO (M.O. Dental)candidate is not able to procure the NOC from the Director Dental Health Services, H.P./ competent authority, then such candidates will be considered under Direct category and not under In-service category.
- 10. Category once opted will not be changed.
- 11. Online Counseling for admission will be held as per the schedule in prospectus. No separate intimation will be sent. However, candidates are advised to regularly stay in touch with the websites, regarding the important dates to identify the current status of Centralized /Common Counseling for admission.
- 1. All matters and disputes related to PG (MDS) counseling are subject to legal jurisdiction of courts in Shimla only.

PART-A

1. INTRODUCTION

- 1.1. The Department of Medical Education will conduct Centralized /Common Counseling for filling-up of 50% State Quota PG (MDS) Degree seats in H.P. Govt. Dental College & Hospital Shimla, 50% State Quota and 50% Management Quota seats in private un-aided Dental Colleges of the State. The H.P. state merit list shall be drawn by the Principal-cum-Member Secretary, HP,GDC,(MDS) Counseling Committee on the basisofNEET-MDS-2021and of those candidates who have applied on the prescribed Application Form within the stipulated date as mentioned in the Prospectus for admission to PG(MDS) degree courses for the academic session 2021-2024.
- 1.2 Presently, there is one Govt. Dental College in Shimla and three Private un-aided Dental Colleges in the State which are running the Post-graduate courses (MDS) duly approved/recognized by the Dental Council of India and affiliated with the H.P. University, Shimla.
- 1.3 H.P. Government Dental College & Hospital, Shimla (HP).
 - The Government of Himachal Pradesh started BDS course in H. P. Government Dental College & Hospital, Shimla with 20 BDS admissions from the academic session 1994-95. Now the BDS admissions intake is 75 per year from the academic session 2019-20. This Dental College is duly recognized by Dental Council of India/Govt. of India, Ministry of Health & Family Welfare and is affiliated with the H.P. University, Shimla. This Dental College is also imparting Postgraduate (MDS) Degree Courses for 19 seats(recognized) in 08specialties.
- 1.4 Himachal Dental College & Hospital, Sundernagar, Distt Mandi (HP)Himachal Dental College & Hospital, Sundernagar, Distt. Mandi (HP) is affiliated to the H.P. University and admissions are made to the courses as approved by the DCI/Govt. of India, Ministry of Health & Family Welfare and Govt. of Himachal Pradesh. Presently there are 60 BDS admissions per year in this College. This Pvt. Dental College is also imparting Postgraduate (MDS) Degree Courses for 27 seats (recognized) in 05 specialties.
- 1.5 Bhojia Dental College & Hospital, (Budh) Baddi, Distt. Solan (HP)
- Bhojia Dental College & Hospital, (Budh) Baddi, Distt. Solan (HP) is affiliated to the H.P. University and admissions are made to the courses as approved by the DCI/Govt. of India, Ministry of Health & Family Welfare and Govt. of Himachal Pradesh. Presently there are 60 BDS admissions per year in this Pvt. Dental College. This Pvt. Dental College is also imparting Postgraduate (MDS) Degree Courses for21 seats (recognized) in 06 specialities.
- 1.6 Himachal Institute of Dental Sciences, Paonta Sahib, Distt. Sirmour.
- Himachal Institute of Dental Sciences, Paonta Sahib, Distt. Sirmour (HP) is affiliated to the H.P. University and admissions are made to the courses as approved by DCI/Govt. of India, Ministry of Health & Family Welfare and Govt. of Himachal Pradesh. Presently there are 100 BDS admission per year in this Pvt. Dental College. This Pvt. Dental College is also imparting Postgraduate (MDS) Degree Courses for 29 seats (recognized) in 07 specialties.

Note: (i) The number of seats is tentative andmay be increased /decreased as per the recommendations of Dental Council of India and exigencies of circumstances.

- (ii) The Postgraduate Courses (MDS) may be added, altered or deleted as per the recommendations of Dental Council of India/GOI.
- (iii) Seats permitted after 28thFebruary, 2021 will not be considered for admission/allotment for the Academic Session 2021-22.
- (iv) In case any fresh subject for postgraduate degree courses is added, the same shall be entered at the bottom of the existing degree courses (up-to 28.02.2021).
- (v) Any postgraduate MDS seat(s) left unfilled in any regular session will not be carried forward to the next or subsequent academic session(s).
- (vi) As per directions of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in W.P. (C) 267/2017 DAR-US-SLAM EDUCATIONAL TRUST and Ors. Vs. MEDICAL COUNCIL OFINDIA and Ors. dated 9-5-2017 "After the second round of counseling for All India Quota seats, the students who take the admission in All India Quota Seats should not be allowed/permitted to vacate the seats. Keeping the above directions in view Candidates are advised to take a calculated decision of continuing in Second round of AlQ as they would not be permitted to resign from 2nd round of All India Quota. They will also not be allowed to participate in any Counselling after joining in Second Round of AlQ.
- (vii For the academic session 2021-22, reservation to EWS will be provided in Govt. Dental College as per direction of the Central Govt. and Dental Council of India for which proposal with regard to increase MDS seats in H.P. Govt. Dental College, Shimla under EWS scheme has already been submitted to the Dental Council of India, New Delhi. In case approval/permission with regard to increase of MDS seats will be received on or before conduction of 1st round of Centralized /Common Counseling from Govt. of India /Dental Council of India, then wide publicity in this regard will be made amongst the EWS candidates through official website of DME& R, H.P. and HPGDC, Shimla.

3. ELIGIBILITY AND SELECTION CRITERIA:

3.1 (A) FOR IN-SERVICE GDO (M.O. DENTAL):

3.1 (A) INCENTIVE FOR PURSUING POST GRADUATION WITHIN THE STATE THROUGH NEET-PGMDS-2021 :

- **3.1.1** There shall be no requirement for a NOC to appear in NEET-PG-MDS for any of the GDO candidates.
- 3.1.2 There shall be requirement of an Incentive Certificate for availing the incentive for serving in the State as a GDO provided that such Incentive Certificate shall be issued to only those GDO who have completed at least one year of uninterrupted continuous service without any break or unauthorized absence on the date of declaration of result of NEET-PG-MDS-2021 i.e. 31-12-2020. Further provided that this Incentive Certificate shall be valid only for appearing in the State Quota counselling.
- **3.1.**3 The application for issuance of Incentive Certificate shall be made by the desirous GDO to the concerned Chief Medical Officer under whom he/she is currently serving.

The application shall be made on a prescribed format which shall be notified by the DDHS separately as per the date mentioned in the schedule which shall be displayed separately on the concerned web-site. The concerned Chief Medical Officer shall verify the service particulars of the GDO from the maintained service record and send the Incentive Certificate for counter signature of the DDHS and DDHS should provide the Incentive certificate to the concerned GDOs as per the date mentioned in the schedule which shall be displayed separately on the concerned web-site

3.1.4 The GDOs shall be entitled for an incentive in terms of percentage of marks obtained in NEET-PG-MDS based on their services rendered in various field postings as given below as per PG policy notified the State Government vide Notification No. HFW-B(F)4-9/2017-III dated 27/02/2019 and subsequent Notification No.HFW-B(F)4-9/2017-III dated 19: 6-2019

The percentage incentive shall be computed on pro-rata basis for the actual duration of service rendered in a particular field posting as per the following formula:

Incentive percentage for		Duration served (in days)		prescribed incentive for
a particular field posting	=	365	– X	particular institution (As mentioned above)

In case a particular GDO has been posted at one particular station but he is deputed for some period to another station, the actual duration served at a particular field posting will be taken into account for the calculation of incentive. This incentive shall be available to only those GDOs who are in the active service of the State in a continuous manner and for the purpose of computing the incentive, the present

continuous service shall be taken into account; meaning thereby, any doctor who has served as a GDO in the past but has subsequently resigned from GDO ship shall not be eligible to avail benefit of this incentive on the basis of any previous service. Similarly, if he/she subsequently joins GDO ship again, the incentive will be calculated taking into consideration the latest period of service reckoned from the date when he/she is in continuous service without any break. This incentive will be subject to maximum of 30% in terms of judgment delivered by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India on 16th August, 2016 in Civil Appeal No.: 8047/2016- State of U.P. &Ors. Versus Dr. Dinesh Singh Chauhan and as per Dental Council of India MDS Regulations, 2017.

- 3.1.5 For the purpose of computation of incentive by the DDHS, the cut off date shall be the date of declaration of NEET-PG-MDS-2021result i.e.31st of December, 2020.
- **3.1.**6 The date schedule for issuance of such Incentive Certificate shall be notified by the DME **and Principal-cum-Member Secretary** either as a part of Prospectus or separately(Refer to websites)
- **3.1.7** No application for issuance of Incentive Certificate shall be entertained after the expiry of period mentioned in notification as per clause 3.1.6. If any GDO fails to make application before the expiry of the last date prescribed for the purpose it shall be presumed that he/she is not interested in availing the benefit of the incentive.
- 3.1.8 The incentive applicable for each field posting for a particular candidate shall be calculated, summed up and rounded off to three decimal points by the DDHS. The candidate is required to procure the incentive certificate him/her-self from the competent authorities and candidate has to upload scanned copy of the same on the mentioned website while registering for counselling for drawing up a combined merit list in respect of GDO and Direct candidates. The individual original Incentive Certificate shall be filed in the personal record of the GDO.
- **3.1.**9 No incentive shall be applicable for those GDOs who are appearing for the All-India counseling.
- 3.1.10 If any GDO joins Post Graduation within or outside the state through NEET-PG exam/Autonomous Institution Entrance Examination as a direct candidate without due resignation/permission, in case of contractual GDO his/her services shall be deemed terminated and recovery shall be made as per terms of contract agreement and in case of regular GDO candidate, disciplinary proceedings shall be initiated besides writing to the concerned Head of Institute for cancellation of the admission.
- **3.1.11** For the purpose of incentive, PG/SS policy notified by the Govt. vide notification No. HFW-B(F)4-9/2017-II dated 27.02.2019 are applicable from the academic session 2019-20. The GDOs M.O. (Dental) who have served in filed posting in the past will awarded incentive as per previous Govt. Notification dated 20.3.2017 (and amended from time to time) and any In-service GDO (M.O. Dental) who is serving /will service in any fled posting will be entitled for incentive as prescribed in the PG/SS Govt. policy dated 27.2.2019.
- Note: 1. For allotment of MDS seats, a combined merit list will be prepared for the allotment of seats amongst Direct and GDOs candidates for 50% State Quota and 50% Management Quota for MDS course seats. The allocation shall be made in order of merit -cum-preference of speciality and college.
- **2.**If any of the 50% AIQ seats remain unfilled, the same shall revert to State Quota and shall be filled-up as per rankings of State Merit.

(B) ELIGIBLTY FOR DIRECT CANDIDATES:

The terms &conditions for Direct Candidates will be as follows:-

- (i) Only the candidates who have qualified the NEET- MDS 2021 shall be eligible to apply online for admission to MDS Courses through Centralized/Common Counseling for taking admission in Government and Private un-aided Dental Colleges situated in Himachal Pradesh.
 - (ii) Graduates (BDS) of Govt. and Private Dental Colleges of the Himachal Pradesh (i.e. H.P. Govt. Dental College& Hospital, Shimla/Himachal Dental College,Sundernagar, Distt. Mandi /Bhojia Dental College & Hospital, Baddi Distt. Solan/ MN,DAV Dental College, Tatul, Distt. Solan and Himachal Institute of Dental Sciences, Paonta Sahib, Distt. Sirmour).
 - (iii). Bonofide Himachalis who have done BDS from any institute recognized by DCI.
 - (iv) Children/Spouse of H.P. Government employees /employees of Autonomous Bodies wholly or partially financed by H.P. Government getting admission to BDS course, through CBSE/NEET or any other All India entrance Examination Dental Colleges in India recognized G.O.I /DCI.

(C) FOR 50% MANAGEMENT QUOTA SEATS(Only in Pvt. Dental Colleges):

The 50% Management Quota MDS seats in Pvt. Un-aided Dental College of the State of H.P. shall be filled up from the qualified candidates of NEET-MDS, 2021 in order of merit-cum-preference of specality and college. Any interested candidate can apply for admission to MDS Degree Course subject to fulfillment of qualification and other terms and condition as prescribed in the Prospectus. There is no condition of Bonafide Himachali/Graduate(BDS)from institutes situated in H.P.to apply under this quota seats.

- (D) Economically Weaker Sections (EWSs):means the persons who fulfilled the criteria as prescribed by the Government of Himachal Pradesh Department of Personal (AP-III) vide letter No. Per (AP)-C-B(12)-1/2019 dated 11-6-2019. As per aforesaid letter, the persons who are not covered under the scheme of reservation for SCs, STs and OBC and whose family has gross annual income below Rs.4.00 lakh(Rupees four lakh only) are to be identified as EWSs for benefit of reservation. Income shall also include income from all sources i.e. salary ,agriculture, business, profession ,etc. for the financial year prior to the year of application .Also persons whose family owns or possesses any of the following assets shall be excluded from being identified as EWS, irrespective of the family income:-
 - (i) More than 1 hectare of Agriculture Land in rural areas and 500 M² land un urban areas;
 - (ii) Residential flat /house of more than 2500 square feet in rural/urban areas;
 - (iii) Family of income tax payee;
 - (iv) Family of Regular /Contract employees of the Central Government, State Government, Board, Corporation and Autonomous bodies and Public Sector Undertakings etc.

Note:- The Candidate claiming the benefit of reservation under EWSs category is required to submit the certificate on the prescribed format **as per Appendix-6**duly issued by the competent authority of the state of Himachal Pradesh.

(E). Eligibility for foreign Nationals: - Foreign nationals are only eligible for Management quota seats in private un-aided Dental Colleges of the State in order of merit -cum-preference of speciality and college. However as per provision contained in NEET-MDS-2021 Prospectus at clause 4.9.2, foreign national should have temporary registration from Dental Council of India at the time of admission in the allotted college failing which his /her admission can not be accepted by the concerned college .

In addition, it is the responsibility of the college where a foreign National is seeking admission to get antecedents verified from the concerned Govt. of the candidate.

3.2 CANDIDATES SEEKING ADMISSION SHALL: -

- (a) Posses BDS degree of Himachal Pradesh University or any other University recognized by Dental Council of India as provided at clause 3.1(b)(i),ii & iii) (C) above Rotatory compulsory Internship should be completed latest by 31-3-2021.
- (b) Candidate must be registered with either Dental Council of India or any of the State Dental Council in India at the time of 1st round of common counselling.
- (c) The candidate possessing foreign qualifications (BDS Degree) will have to produce the certificate of having passed the DCI examination as well as certificate of recognition by DCI at the time of 1st round of Centralized /Common counselling and the said registration should have been renewed to be valid at the time of counselling.
- (d) The above qualifications will only determine the eligibility of a candidate for admission, but the admission shall be made through centralized/Common Counselling committee on the basis of merit drawn by the Counselling Committee of those qualified candidates of NEET-MDS-2021 who have submitted online application form successfully with requisite transaction of fee within stipulated period.
- (e) Candidates who do not fulfill the eligibility criteria as prescribed for State Quota Seats, will be considered only for Management Quota seats in private un-aided Dental Colleges.
- (f) The candidate already perusing MDS from anywhere in Country will be deemed ineligible to for admission in MDS course for the academic session 2021-22.
- 3.3 In case, the eligible candidates to the extent of reservation in any category are not available and the seat is unfilled, the vacant seats shall be filled up by converting them in the other categories subject to availability of candidates during the Mop up round of Centralized /Common Counseling as given below:
 - a) The vacant/unfilled seats of SC category shall be filled up amongst the eligible ST category candidates.
 - b) The vacant/unfilled seats of ST category shall be filled up from amongst the eligible SC category candidates.
 - c) In case, the eligible candidate are not available in the above two reserved categories in the above manner, the vacant seats shall then be filled up from amongst the eligible unreserved candidates.
 - d) The vacant seats /unfilled seat of Person with Disability shall be filled-up from General category candidates.

- e) The candidature of SC/ST candidates belonging to other state (Non-HP) will only be considered for general category by virtue of their general combined merit.
- f) As per 40-point roster there is no specific point earmark to OBC, hence the OBC candidates will be considered in General Category as per General combined merit.

Note: (i) Candidates who do not fulfill the eligibility criteria as prescribed for State Quota Seats, will be considered only for Management Quota seats, if otherwise they are Interested including foreign national.

- (ii) The reverted back All India Quota seats shall be allotted in order of merit –cumpreference of course /college by applying 40 point reservation roster in continuation to the last roster point exhausted in 1st round . The method for applying roster during the 2nd round /Mop up/subsequent rounds for vacant seats including reverted seats from All India Quota will be as follows:-
 - (a). The 40 point reservation roster shall be applied in continuation to the last point exhausted in 1st round initially to the seats which are reverted back from All India Quota to State quota in H.P. Govt. Dental College, Shimla and subsequently the roster shall be applied in continuation on the unfilled seats of round –I counselling.
 - (b) . No fresh 40 point reservation roster shall be applied on the vacant seats of State quota Round -1 (due to non-joining of candidates of Round -I) as well as resultant vacancy arising due to upgradation in the $2^{\rm nd}$ round where the roster has already been applied in $1^{\rm st}$ round .  - (iii). 40 point roster exhausted up-to point 21in the last year session 2020-21,hence now will start from point 22.
- (v). 5% seats of the annual sanctioned intake capacity shall be filled up by persons with Benchmark disability in accordance with provisions of the Rights of Persons with disability Act, 2016 and as per direction of Dental Council of India based on merit list of National Eligibility-cum-Entrance Test -2021 for admission to Post Graduate Course in Govt. and Private Dental College of the State. Person with disability candidates who intend to take admission in Govt. and Private Dental Colleges of the State through Centralized Counselling have to obtain the certificate of disability as per **Appendix-5** from the Medical Board of the Indira Gandhi Medical College and Hospital, Shimla or Dr. Rajendra Prasad Govt. Medical College and Hospital Kangra at Tanda. The specified disability as prescribed by the Dental Council of India is attached with the **Appendix-5-A** (Disability Certificate).
- (vii). If Person with disability stands in General combined merit list, he/she will be seat which falls under General category point by virtue of his /her General combined merit. In that event point of General category shall be treated exhausted. If the point earmarked to Person with disability remain unfilled on account unavailability of candidate, the point shall be included in the annual sanctioned seats for the respective category i.e. General category.
- (viii). If EWS stands in General combined merit list, he/she will be seat which falls under General category point by virtue of his /her General combined merit. In that event point of General category shall be treated exhausted. If the point earmarked to EWS remain unfilled on account unavailability of candidate, the point shall be included in the annual sanctioned seats for the respective category i.e. General category.
 - Note:(i) In case, permission of renewal of MDS seats is not received for the academic session 2021-22 from DCI/Central Govt. of India, then relevant rosters will be treated exhausted as per availability of seats.
 - (i) In case fresh seat is introduced under State quota and Management Quota for the academic session 2021-22 either in H.P. Govt. Dental College or Pvt. un-aided Dental College, then the above mentioned rosters will be applied in continuation.

 - **b.** If the attempts made in passing the 4th/final professional are also the same, then a candidate who has obtained higher aggregate over all total marks in the BDS Degree examinations only will rank senior.
 - **c.** If the overall obtained marks in the BDS Degree examination are also the same, then a candidate older in age will rank senior to a candidate who is younger in age.

5. COUNSELLING SCHEDULE AND ADMISSION PROCEDURE

- 5.1 There will be online counselling system to make the provisional allocation of the available seats to the eligible candidates, allocation will be made in order of merit-cumchoices /preferences of the specialty, college and quota filled in the online admission application form by the candidate within the stipulated period by using Counseling committee website www.hpgdcshimla.org. www.hpmds.smartpad.in/. Candidates can edit the choices/ preferences of Specialty, colleges and quota within the given time till the locking/cut of time. Therefore, candidates are advised to take care during filling up the orders of choices/preferences of Speciality, college(s) and quota.
- **5.2.** The admission process in the Government Dental Colleges and private DentalColleges (State & Management Quota) shall be completed by online allotment within the prescribed schedule through the Centralized/Common Counseling Committee constituted by the

Government of Himachal Pradesh under the Chairmanship of the Director Medical Education & Research, H.P. Shimla. All the Principals of the Dental Colleges including Joint/Additional Director, Directorate of Medical Education & Research, and Himachal Pradesh are its members and the Principal, H.P. Govt. Dental College, Shimla is its Member Secretary.

5.3 After provisional allocation of seats during the first and subsequent rounds of counseling, candidates can download provisional allocation letters from the www.hpmds.smartpad.in/. website after login to their account and report to the Principal of the respective college along with all requisite original documents and print out of confirmation copy of online application form with photocopies of the all-requisite documents (duly self-attested) for verification as per requirement of the prospectus. After verification of original documents by the Scrutiny Committee and fulfillment of the prescribed eligibility criteria, medical fitness and fee deposition etc. by the Candidate of the concerned college, the candidates will report to the allocated college for their joining. If the candidate does not follow aforesaid process within stipulated period as specified in the Counselling schedule his/her allocated seat shall be cancelled automatically without any intimation and his/her seat shall be declared as vacant for subsequent round of counseling and penalty (if applicable) shall also be imposed as per provision of the prospectus.

5.4 (a) After completion of 1st round of Counselling, the 2nd round of Counselling shall be conducted as per schedule by the Counselling Committee, the online Counselling form shall made available the H.P. Govt. Dental college website be on www.hpmds.smartpad.in/.Candidates are required to fill up choices/preferences of Speciality, college(s) and quota afresh within stipulated period for MDS PROSPECTUS-2021 for provisional allocation against vacant seats or the seats fallen vacant due to shifting. All candidates who are eligible to apply are entitled to fill up the online Counselling form for 2nd round of Counselling. If candidate is satisfied with his/her seat allocated during the 1st round of online counselling, he/she is not required to participate in the subsequent round of online counselling. Shifting/up-gradation from one College to another colleges and one Speciality to another speciality shall also be made during the 2nd round of counselling. Pursuant to the judgment passed by the Hon'ble High Court of H.P. on 10.07.2020 in CWP No. 2160 of 2020- Gunjan Thakur and Others Vs. State of H.P. and others, candidates those applied for 2nd round of Centralized Counselling afresh, their merit will be clubbed with the earlier General combined merit list (of round-I) and during the 2nd round allotment will be made according to afresh list in order of merit -cum-choices/preference for admissions against vacant seats in Govt. and private Dental Colleges of the State . Same procedure shall be followed in Mop up round /subsequent round Centralized /Common Counseling. Fresh new Registration for Round-2 are applicable to those candidates who (a) Have not registered in Round-I(with have to pay application and taken amount as mentioned in the Prospectus) (b) round-1 can logging again and will have to pay only who have resigned / not reported in token money but no need to deposit application fee for such candidates (c) candidate who registered for Round-I and did not get any seat allotted need not to register again. However, he /she will have to pay token money and will be required to fill fresh choices for speciality / quota and College.

If candidate is satisfied with his /her seat allocated during the 1st round of online counseling, he /she is not required to participate in the subsequent round of online counseling. In case

he/she wants up gradation /shifting, then he/she will have to give fresh preference as per available seat matrix in every subsequent rounds failing which the seat allocated in the previous rounds will be treated as final . However, if the seat remains vacant then, the said forfeited money will be transferred to the concerned private Dental College.
- (b) It is pertinent to mention here that the candidates can fill the choices of colleges Speciality/quota which are not reflecting in the vacancy position of seats, as few seats may arise due to shifting of candidates during 2ndround of counseling from one college to another as per their choices/preferences by vacating the already occupied seat of 1st round of counseling. In this regard, it is made clear that some seats of Persons with Disability (PwD) seats etc. may remain vacant after exhausting all candidates of respective quota/category. In view thereof, seats of any category/quota may become vacant in 2nd round due to shifting/conversion of seats. Hence, it is not mandatory to fill only those choices/preferences which are reflected in the vacancy position of seats. Therefore, candidates are advised to fill the preferences/choices of colleges as per their choice. The seats in 2ndround will be allocated as per availability of seats as per merit- cum -choice/preference submitted by the candidate.
- 4.6 . After completion of 1st & 2nd round of counselling, the schedule for Mop-up round of counselling shall be issued by the Counselling Committee and the online counselling form shall be made available on the College/Vendor website www.hpgdcshimla.org and www.hpmds.smartpad.in Candidates who are eligible for participating in the mop-up round of online counseling are required to fill up fresh choices/preferences of course, college and quota in the online application form within stipulated period for provisional allocation against vacant seats or seats which may fall vacant due to shifting along with requisite amount as prescribed for token amount of fee, as applicable. If candidate is satisfied with his/her seat allocated during the previous rounds (1st and 2nd) of online counselling, he/she is not required

to participate in the Mop up /subsequent round of online counselling. Shifting for upgradation of course and quota from private Dental Colleges to Govt. Dental College and Private Dental Colleges to Private Dental College in order of merit-cum-choices/preferences of the course, college & quota shall be allowed. Choices filled in the concerned round will apply for allocation in that round and all previous round choices will be deemed to have been cancelled after filling up of new options.

- Note: (i) Candidates who had not participated/allocated seats in the 1st & 2nd rounds of counseling can also participate in the mop-up round(s) of counseling as per their NEET-MDS -2021 merit rank subject to their eligibility.
- (ii) Candidates are advised to remain in touch with the College websites regularly for any change in the counselling /admission process as well as latest updating upto the last closing date of admission and Counselling Committee shall no way be responsible for non communication on this account. For any query, please contact on Tel. No.0177-2658838 & 0177-2652562.
- 4.7. The Himachali bonafide candidates admitted under management quota in the private Dental colleges can also be up graded to the State Quota Seat, if he/she applied to the state quota seat in the colleges concerned against vacant/drop-out seats, if any, in order of merit as the case, may be, subject to fulfillment of the eligibility criteria as prescribed for State Quota seats.
- 4.8. If required, Final Mop up round of Centralized /Common Counselling will be conducted in physical mode. In the event of physical counseling, the candidates are required to remit the aforesaid token amount /Registration fee in the shape of Bank Draft to be drawn in favour of the Principal, H.P. Govt. Dental College, Shimla. Rest of Terms and Conditions will remain same and deposition of fee may have to be done at the time of allotment of seat.
- 4.9. The final eligibility of the candidates shall be determined after verification of all original documents strictly as per provisions of the prospectus by the Scrutiny Committee constituted by the Principal of the concerned Dental college. However, it will be the entire responsibility of the candidates concerned to supply correct and authenticated information on the online Application form. The Application Forms of ineligible candidates will be rejected by the centralized counseling committee. No request for change of category once opted/filled in the online Application Form after issuance of category-wise merit list during the course of online counselling will be entertained under any circumstances. It is further clarified that the candidates will be allocated seats provisionally on the basis of their merit rank-cumchoices/preferences and as far as their final eligibility is concerned, the Counselling Committee shall, in no way be responsible, if they are found to be ineligible at the time of admission in the allocated college, leading to cancellation of their seat or any other consequence emanating from the same. It will be the sole responsibility of the Principal of the colleges concerned to admit the eligible candidates to the course as per provisions of the prospectus. Candidates must satisfy himself/herself about the prescribed eligibility criteria of the prospectus before taking admission to the course. In the event of his/her ineligibility to be detected at later stage, his/her admission shall liable to be cancelled without any notice. Any wrong or misleading entry or documentation in the form will lead to the rejection of the

candidature at any stage without assigning any reason for which the candidate(s) would be solely responsible.

- 4.10. The candidates who are allocated MDS seats afresh in the Government and private Dental Colleges during the 2nd and Mop-up Rounds of Counselling, such candidates in respect of Government Dental/ Private Dental Colleges are required to remit Admission Registration fee of Rs. 20,000/- for state quota seat and = Rs. 50,000/- Private Dental Colleges/(Management Quota) while filling up their online counseling form as per their choices/preferences, failing which no seat shall be allotted to them. The aforesaid amount of fee shall be adjusted in the tuition fee by the colleges concerned. The candidates who will join to MDS course in the allotted Government Dental Colleges and Private Dental Colleges in the State within stipulated time, they shall be considered eligible for further mop-up and subsequent rounds of counseling for upgradation of specialty subject to availability of seats as per options filed in the application form, if any. In case, any of the candidate does not join the course in the allotted college within stipulated time, then his/her amount of aforesaid fee shall be forfeited. The Counseling Committee shall transfer the amount of only finally admitted candidates to the colleges concerned after completion of admission process within two months. However, in the case of Private College, the candidates seeking admission to MDS course under State/Management Quota in Private Dental College of the State during the 2nd round and subsequent rounds of counselling, Rs.20,000/-(State Seat) Rs. 50,000/-(Management Seat) amount of fee shall be remitted by the candidates while filling up their online counseling form as per their choices/preferences, failing which no seats shall be allocated to them. However, the remaining fee and other charges including hostel charges etc. as applicable for the course shall be deposited in the college concerned on the day of reporting for admission. Candidates who are allotted seats to MDS course in Private Dental College in the State during 2nd round and mop-up round of counseling (State/Management Quota) and who do not join the course within stipulated period, then the amount of Rs.20,000/ (State) Rs.50,000/- (Management) as registration fee paid by them shall be forfeited. In case of candidates who have not been allocated seats in any round of counselling, the amount of fee shall be refunded without any deduction after completion of admission process tentatively within two months for which the candidates are required to apply on the prescribed format as per Appendix- 10 The Counselling Committee shall transfer the amount of fee of admitted candidates to the colleges concerned after completion of admission process tentatively within two months.
- 4.11. Candidate who brings incomplete documents/certificate(s) at the time of reporting for verification of documents at the level of college for admission, his/her candidature is liable tobe rejected without any notice there and then by the College Scrutiny Committee. However, the College Scrutiny committee reserves the right to take a specific decision taking into account the facts and circumstances of the case. Provided further that in the admission process, the decision of the Director Medical Education & Research, H.P.-cum- Chairman Centralized /Common Counseling Committee shall be final and binding upon to all concerned.
- 4.12. Candidates allocated seats provisionally for admission to MDS courses shall be issued provisional admission letters subject to determination for the final eligibility by the Centralized /Common Counselling Committee, which will be uploaded on

<u>www.hpmds.smartpad.in</u> The candidates are required to download the said letters and report for admission to the concerned Principal of the allocated Dental Colleges within the stipulated period. In case, any candidate does not download his/her admission letter from the website of the College, the College/Counselling Committee shall in, no way be responsible. Lists of allocated candidates will also be uploaded on the website for counselling process from time to time.

MEDICAL EXAMINATION & REGISTRATION

- 1. The selected candidates will be called for medical examination and verification of the documents attached to the original application in the allotted Dental College on their own expenses.
- 2. The standard of physical fitness will be as prescribed in Appendix- 8 of the prospectus along with negative COVID-19 test, if declared unfit he/she will not be admitted in the College.
- 3. Every candidate coming from other Universities/Boards for admission to MDS courses in the Colleges has to produce migration certificate at the time of admission in the college.
- 4. Soon after the admission in the Dental College, the students will get themselves registered with the University, the course is affiliated to on payment of prescribed fee.

PART - B

1. ADMISSION

- 1.1 The Centralized / Common Counseling for admission to 50% State Quota Postgraduate Degree (MDS) courses in H.P. Govt. Dental College, Shimla, 50% State Quota and 50% Management Quota Seats in Private Un-aided Dental College of the State in various specialties will be held as per prescribed scheduled and distribution of seats given in the Prospectus.
- 1.2 The selected candidates will be required to deposit the prescribed fee at the time of counseling/admission, failing which the seat will be allotted to next candidate in order of merit. The necessary instructions will be issued by the Director Medical Education & Research, H.P. Shimla-cum- Chairman Centralized /Common Counseling Committee and Member Secretary-cum-Principal H.P. Govt. Dental College Shimla Centralized /Counseling Committee.
- 1.3 If a candidate, after admission to any of the course, has absence without any valid reason of more than six weeks at a stretch during the period of training than his/her name will be struck off from the rolls. However, for medical reasons if this period is beyond six weeks then the candidate will be allowed to sit in the subsequent examinations depending on the total duration of such leave in such a way that the total tenure of PG course should not be less than 36 months and also that his/her total attendance should not be less than 80% in theory and practical each.
- **1.4** Frequent and habitual absentees will be summarily discharged from the college and the agreement bond money will be recovered from them.

- 1.5 The academic sessions are specified in the prospectus and may vary from time to time as decided by the Dental Council of India/GOI.
- 1.6 The other conditions are specified in the Prospectus and may vary from time to time as decided by Himachal Pradesh Government/Dental Council of India/Govt. of India.
- 1.7 (i) The H.P. Govt. reserves the right to alter the prospectus and terms & conditions at any time and such alternative shall be binding on the students and management of Pvt. Dental colleges.
 - (ii) The students admitted to the Dental Colleges shall be governed by the provisions of the rules prescribed by the State Govt. /H.P.University/DCI from time to time which shall be binding on all the students and management of Pvt. Dental colleges.
- 1.8 The Hon'ble High Court in its order in CWP No. 310 of 2004 has upheld the ban imposed by the State Govt. on holding the gate meetings, general body meetings and slogan shouting etc. in Dental College, Hospital and Hostels attached therewith and within a distance of 500 meters from these institutions. Violation can be proceeded against for committing contempt of Hon'ble High Court. This is in addition to other suitable punitive action as deemed necessary.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF BOND FOR POST GRADUATION:

2.1 As the Government incurs substantive expenditure on each candidate for doing Post Graduation and also pays them full pay along with all allowances and seniority during the course, every GDO (regular/contract) who have been sponsored to pursue Post Graduation within the State in Govt. and Pvt. Un-aided Dental colleges shall have to furnish a bond to serve the State for at least four years including mandatory first year of field posting after completion of their respective courses. Since the direct candidate who pursues Post Graduation within the State in Government Dental college on State/All India Quota stand on a different footing as they are entitled to service benefits including full pay (with allowances and increments) and chances of regularisation to which their GDO counterparts are entitled; however, keeping in view the resources expended in their education by the Government including payment of stipend, every such direct candidates shall have to furnish a bond to serve the State for at least two years including mandatory first year of field posting after completion of their respective courses.

2.2 The bond as per clause 2.1 shall be in the following form:

- 2.2.1 All the candidates as per clause 2.1 shall furnish a bond in the form of a legal undertaking to serve the State for prescribed period failing which the candidate shall have to pay the Rs. 40 Lacs to the State Government. The candidate shall also furnish an undated cheque from a scheduled bank amounting to Rs. 40 Lacs in the name of DDHS. The DDHS shall be at liberty to get the cheque en cashed in event of violation of the bond conditions.
- 2.2.2 The candidates as per clause 2.1 shall also deposit their original bachelor degree with the DDHS (in case of GDOs) and DME (in case of direct candidates). The concerned issuing University/Institution shall be informed about such retention and the candidate shall be debarred from obtaining any duplicate degree. The original bachelor degree shall be released only after completion of the Bond Period or after deposition of the requisite amount and this shall be a part of the bond agreement.

- 2.2.3 The candidates shall also furnish undertaking as a part of bond that they shall complete the course prescribed failing which they shall be liable to pay Rs. 10 lakhs to the State Government for wastage of seat.
- 2.2.4 The prescribed format of the Bond Agreement shall be as per APPENDIX-6.
- 2.3 It shall be the sole responsibility of DDHS to ensure the furnishing of such documents from each GDO candidate who is being sponsored and the sole responsibility of the Principal of concerned **Dental College** to ensure collection of these documents at the time of admission of a direct candidate to the course. Any dereliction of duty in this end shall make the concerned liable for action.
 - **2.4** The custodian of these three documents-Bonds as legal undertaking undated cheque and original Bachelors degree shall be DDHS (in case of GDOs) and Principals of respective colleges (in case of Direct candidates, as per power delegated by the DME.) The DDHS shall take over the custody of the documents including the Bond agreement undated cheque and Original Bachelor degree in respect of State Service candidates.
- 2.5 In no case, NOC will be granted for second Post-graduation course/Senior Residency to any candidate during the mandatory period of service of the State after first Post Graduation.

2.6 The following shall constitute a violation of the bond to serve the state as outlined in Clause 2.1

- 2.6.1 Failure to join the given field posting within 10 days of issuance of orders.
- 2.6.2 Putting in request for EOL/Study leave/request for NOC during the mandatory period of service of the State.
- 2.6.3 Putting in request for Senior Residency within the mandatory first year of field posting.

2.7 In the event of a candidate violating the terms of bond as outlined in clause 2.6, the following actions shall be initiated by the DDHS:

- 2.7.1 The salary paid to the candidate during sponsorship shall be recovered through due process of law.
- 2.7.2 The bond amount shall be recovered through due process of law. The cheque submitted by the candidate as a part of bond documents shall be en-cashed.
- 2.7.3 Initiation of disciplinary proceedings against the GDO candidate.
- 2.7.4 The original bachelor degree shall not be returned and endorsement shall be made to the concerned University thereof.
- 2.7.5 Cancellation of registration from the concerned State Dental Council.
- **2.8 EXCEPTIONS**: The condition of bond shall not be applicable in case of Direct candidate in the following scenarios:
 - 2.8.1 Those direct candidates who do not choose to take any stipend during the post graduation in the state. Such candidates shall furnish such option on a prescribed affidavit before the start of course.
 - 2.8.2 Those direct candidate in whose case the Government/DDHS fails to issue any orders for field postings within a month of their clearing the PG Exams. However, the DHS/DDHS would be answerable to the Government for this lapse.

3. REMUNERATION DURING POST GRADUATION:

- 3.1 GDOs appointed on contract basis and sponsored for pursuing post graduation within the State shall be paid the contractual salary as per their contract agreement.
- 3.2 Regular GDOs sponsored for pursuing post graduation within the State and outside the State on sponsored quota seats of Autonomous Institutions as per PG policy clause 5.3 shall be treated on duty during the prescribed period of Post Graduation and he/she shall be paid the regular pay, allowances including increments for such prescribed period. In case, the sponsored GDO is not able to complete the Post

- Graduation within the prescribed time period, the extra period spent during Post Graduation beyond the prescribed period may be regularized against the leave of kind due. If there is no sufficient leave of kind due in his/her credit, that period shall be treated as EOL and the payment made to the person for this period shall be recovered from the candidates.
- 3.3 Direct candidates shall be paid stipend as applicable to them subject to the exception, if chosen for, as per clause 2.8.1 in H.P. Govt. Dental College & Hospital, Shimla as per existing rates Rs.35,000/-, Rs.40,000/- and Rs.45,000/- per month for the first, second and third year of the MDS course respectively.
- 3.4 As per DCI regulation, 2017, the post-graduate students shall be paid stipend only for duration of three years of the course, as may be fixed by the State Government or such authority as the respective State Government/Administration may authorize.

4. REMUNERATION DURING THE MANDATORY FIELD POSTING:

- 4.1 The regular GDO shall continue to draw the emoluments and pay admissible to him/her with due allowances and increments during the period of mandatory field posting.
- 4.2 The contractual GDO shall continue to draw the salary as admissible to him as per terms of the contract.
- 4.3 The Direct candidates shall draw remuneration at the rate as admissible for contract and shall be treated as contractual GDOs for all practical purposes during the period of mandatory field posting. However, if the direct candidate subsequently joins as Senior Resident in any of the Dental/Medical Colleges after completion of mandatory first year of field posting, he shall draw the pay as prescribed for a Senior Resident.

5 TERMS FOR LEAVING POST GRADUATION COURSE MIDWAY:

- 5.1 If the GDO's who have been granted sponsorship for pursuing Post Graduation within the State, leaves the Post Graduation course midway, he/she shall be debarred to re-appear in any entrance examination for Post Graduation for the next five years within and outside the State of Himachal Pradesh. The period of five years for the purpose of de-barring shall be reckoned from the date of leaving the course midway.
- 5.2 In addition to this, for those GDO's who leave post graduation course mid way, the period spent in the Dental College during Post Graduation may be regularized against the leave of kind due. If there is no sufficient leave of kind due in his/her credit that period may be treated as EOL and the payment made to the person for this period shall be recovered from the candidates. In addition to this, the GDO shall have to pay Rs. 10 Lakhs in event of leaving the course midway as per terms of the bond.
- 5.3 In case of direct candidates who leave the course midway (i.e. after 31st May or after completion of admission process), they shall have to pay Rs. 10 lakh to the State Government as per the terms of the bond. Information in respect of such cases shall be sent to the Director Dental of Health Services, H.P. by the concerned Principal along with bond and other documents.

6 TERMS FOR SECOND POST GRADUATION COURSE:

The GDOs who have been sponsored to pursue Post Graduation within the state earlier and who are desirous of pursuing a second Post Graduation Course shall be governed by the following conditions:

6.1 The GDOs who have completed PG Degree in one specialty shall not be granted sponsorship/NOC for pursuing PG Degree in any other specialty. However, such

- candidates may pursue their second PG degree course only after the grant of EOL by the Government as per CCS Leave Rules.
- 6.2 Any GDO who is not fulfilling the condition of minimum required service to be sponsored as Post Graduate Candidate within or out of the state shall have to resign on their selection against direct/open seats before joining such courses. And if he/she joins Post Graduation without getting NOC from the Government or without submitting his/her resignation, in case of contractual GDO his/her services shall be deemed terminated and recovery shall be made as per terms of contract agreement and in case of regular GDO candidate, disciplinary proceedings shall be initiated besides writing to the concerned Head of Institute for cancellation of the admission.

Note: (i) No candidate will be allowed to draw more than one stipend/scholarship/ financial assistance etc.

- (ii) Direct post graduate students shall be entitled for 30 days leave as per academic year during PG course. No carry forward of leave shall be allowed/permissible. The In-service post-graduate students shall avail leave according to the CCS leave rules as applicable to the Govt. servants.
- (iv) The selected candidates are required to execute Agreement Bond as prescribed in the Prospectus at the time of admission, failing which stipend will not be paid to them. The stipend will be paid w.e.f. commencement of academic session. If any candidate submits Agreement Bondafter commencement of academic session, then stipend will be paid to him/her from the date of submission of Agreement Bond the concerned Dental College.

8. FEES AND HOSTEL CHARGES:

Note:1. The above fee structure is subject to any change by the State Government.

- 2. The college fee in full should be deposited by 15th of the month of May every year, and up to the last day of the month with the late fee of 100/- per day. Failure to deposit fee and other dues in full by the last day of month payable shall automatically entail removal of the students name from the roll. He /she however may re-submit the fee on payment of arrears of fee plus re-admission of Rs. 2000/-
- 3. Fees once paid shall not be refunded but in the case of students who are shifting from one institution of other institutions, it will be refunded in all Govt./private institutions provided such shifting takes place within the stipulated last date of admission i.e. before the completion of counseling process.
- 4. In the case of candidates getting selected /admitted in order of merit in H.P. Govt. Dental College, Shimla from any of Private Dental Colleges, the fee will be refunded/adjusted as the case may be.
- **8.2** Examination fee as payable fixed by the University, from time to time.
- 8.3 Postgraduate students residing in the Hostel shall have to vacate the hostel after completion of course (36 months). However, a grace period of 07 days will be given /allowed after the completion of the Clinical/Practical examination. In case the candidate fails to vacate the Hostel beyond the prescribed period, he/she shall be liable for penal rent @ 100/- per day for one month and 300/- per day subsequently.

9. GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS PERTAINING TO POST-GRADUATE DEGREE (MDS) COURSES.

- 9.1 Duration of course: 36 months (3 years) from the date of commencement of session. Provided that the time period required for passing out the MDS course shall be a maximum of six years from date of commencement of session in MDS course as per DCI norms.
- **9.2 Session for admission:** Academic session will commence from the 1st May 2021. Number of students to be admitted in this session will be according to the number of seats available.
- 9.3 Syllabus and Method of Training: Syllabus shall be subject-wise with necessary training in Applied Basic Sciences. Fundamentals of the concerned subject and recent advances with adequate theoretical and practical knowledge of the specialty will be provided. Graded responsibility on the management and treatment of patients and participation in teaching and training programme of under graduate students in their subject will be encouraged. Syllabus and Method of training will be changed as per Dental Council of India.
- 9.4 Examination shall be held twice a year usually in April/May, Annual and October/November, Supplementary every year.
- **9.5.** 1. Thesis shall be compulsory and shall embody the candidates own work under supervisions of qualified Teachers for the purpose as recommended by the Dental Council of India.
 - 2. The protocol of the subjects for approval shall be submitted to a committee consisting of three members (Principal and Senior Most PG Teachers) to be appointed by Dean and submitted as per schedule of Dental Council of India and H.P. University Ordinance as under:-

Protocol for dissertation	The protocol for dissertation should be submitted within 6 months after admission to the Registrar, H.P. University through the Dean i.e. on or before 30 th October. Protocol submitted will be deemed approved, if nothing is heard within periods of 03 months after submission of the protocols and the queries if any will have to be raised in the first instant.
Library Dissertation	To be submitted at the end of 18 months of the course to the Head of the institution i.e. on or before 30 th October for the consecutive year of admission.
Dissertation /Thesis	The dissertation should be submitted within 06 months before the final examination to the Registrar, H.P. University through the Dean i.e. on or before 30 th October i.e. maximum of two and half year of admission.

- 3. After the approval of the plan of the thesis one copy of thesis shall be submitted to the Dean Office and four copies of the thesis shall be submitted to the H.P. University through Dean, after one year of approval of protocols but not less than six months from the scheduled date of final examination/completion of course except in force majeure conditions.
- 4. The acceptance of the thesis shall be a pre-condition for appearing in the final examination. In case the thesis is neither rejected nor approved and revision is suggested the same may be submitted after appearing in written paper, but where the thesis is rejected the candidate will not be allowed to appear in written paper till the outcome of fresh thesis.

9.6 WRITTEN PAPERSHALL BE TWO EXAMINATION PART-I (THEORY) AND PART-II (Theory, Clinical, Oral and Practical):

- 1. **Part-I**: Basic Sciences Paper only Theory shall be conducted at the end of First year of MDS course of three hours duration.
 - Part-II: Examination shall be conducted at the end of Third year of MDS course.
 Part-II Examination shall consist of Paper-I, Paper-II and Paper-III, each of three hours duration of theory along-with a separate Practical examination as per HPU/DCI norms.

9.7 DECLARATION OF RESULT:

- 1. Marks will be assigned of the examination as per DCI /HPU rules.
- 2. If the candidate fails in written paper of MDS examination, he/she can re-appear at the subsequent examination without requiring submitting a fresh thesis.
- 3. Candidate who fails to qualify will be allowed to re-appear in subsequent examination on payment of examination fees.

10. GENERAL DISCIPLIANARY RULES AND REGULATIONS PERTAINING TO POST-GRADUATE DEGREE (MDS) COURSES.

10.1 ATTENDANCE:-

Every candidate shall secure (80% attendance during each academic year

10.2 RAGGING:-

Every student of the college is informed that under the order of the Hon'ble High Court of Himachal Pradesh and the rules framed by the University there under vide Statute 23-A ragging is completely prohibited. Any student found involved in ragging will be summarily expelled from the college and legal proceedings under Criminal law shall be initiated against him/her. Further an affidavit has also to be given by the student and his parents/local guardian that he will not indulge in ragging at the time of his/her admission as per **Appendix**-

7and Appendix-7A of the prospectus and thereafter during his/her tenure of complete PG course.

10.3 **EXAMINATIONS:-**

- (i) Students are not allowed to take into the examination hall text book, notes or manuscript of any kind.
- (ii) Any student found infringing the rules or having recourse to unfair means will be expelled from the examination and the matter reported to the Principal for taking further action.

10.4 **LEAVE:-**

No leave will be granted when examination is due, CCS leave rules are applicable to GDOs and direct candidate respectively.

10.5 **CORRESPONDANCE:**-

- (i) Students are forbidden to address any higher authority directly. Any communication intended for such higher authority must be submitted through the Principal who will forward it, if he considers it desirable. It will not be a binding upon Principal that he/she must forward all such applications.
- (ii) Every student desirous of addressing the Principal by letter must do so separately. Joint applications are entirely prohibited and will not receive attention.
- (iii) Any student wishing to make a representation on any subject has the right of direct access to the Head of the Department during the College hours.
- (iv) The Principal /Professors and the staff are accessible for the consideration of difficulties and grievances of student and will be always pleased to hear them and give advice.

10.6 MISCELLANEOUS:-

- (i) Every student will wish his/her teacher on the occasion of his/her first meeting in the College or outside.
- (ii) Students are required to observe order and quietness at all times in the College.
- (iii) No game of any sort to be played during the hours allotted to lectures / class/Clinical hours.
- (iv) Smoking and use of liquor within the college premises including Hostel is prohibited and the defaulter will be rusticated.
- (v) All irregularities, neglect of duties and breach of discipline are to be brought to the notice of the Principal by the Head of the Department/Professor under whom the students are working.
- (vi) In dealing with any offence in College/Hostel, the Principal may decide whether it is to be met with: any apology, verbal or written, or fine or suspension of scholarship or expulsion from the College/Hostel.
- (vii) Principal is competent to remit the fine imposed by him:
 - a) The decision of the Principal in all cases shall be final.
 - b) Woman students are required to wear simple dress in the College. Use of gaudy dress is prohibited.
 - c) All students must provide themselves with washable white coats which shall be worn while working in the college laboratories or hospital departments, with embodies or separate small name plate.

- d) No association can be formed in the College without prior permission of the Head of Institution.
- e) No student is permitted to write anything on the blackboard unless asked by the teachers to do so.
- f) Student should not take part in politics.
- g) No student should directly talk to media without the permission of Principal of the college.

10.7 HOSTEL:

No hostel facility will be provided in the H. P. Govt. Dental College, Shimla. Students will have to make their own arrangements to stay.

10.8 **LIBRARY:**

There is a library maintained by the college for the students/staff. The member of the library shall abide by the library rules as approved by the Principal, from time to time which are available with the college library.

Note: The State Government reserves the right to alter/amend any provision in the PG Policy at any time/from time to time and rules ®ulations made by H.P. University/ Dental Council of India as the case may be, shall be binding on the students.
